Fr. Joshua Waltz:



Fr. Joshua Waltz received his bachelors of sacred theology in Rome at the Pontifical College of St. Thomas Aquinas. During this time he also obtained a master's degree in moral theology with an emphasis in bioethics. After ordination, Fr. Waltz was assigned the parochial vicar at Christ the King in Mandan and the mission parishes of St. Martin in Huff and St. Anthony in St. Anthony until 2009. During this time and until 2013, Fr. Waltz was also chaplain and instructor at St. Mary's Central High School. From 2009-11, he served as parochial vicar for Spirit of Life parish in Mandan and St. Martin and St. Anthony. Fr. Waltz was then assigned as pastor of St. Hildegard in Menoken and Sacred Heart in Wilton from 2011-13. During that time, he was also the assistant director of vocations for the diocese. Since 2013, he has served as the diocese's director of vocations. July, 2018, Bishop Kagan also appointed Fr. Waltz as parochial administrator of the Church of St. Joseph.

Fr. Jarad Wolf:



Fr. Jarad Wolf, newly ordained this summer is serving his first year as Parochial Vicar for the Church of St. Joseph. Fr. Wolf will also be a part-time teacher of Religion for Light of Christ Catholic Schools. This fall he will also assist the coach football at Saint Mary's. He is from Glen Ullin, ND, and a graduate from New Salem High School. His parents are Joseph and Roslyn, and he is the oldest of 4 children. Fr. Wolf spent 2 years studying at the University of Mary where he discerned a call to the priesthood through the faithful witness of good friends and dedicated priests. Following his entrance into the seminary in the summer of 2012, he spent 2 years studying philosophy at the University of St. Thomas and St. John Vianney Seminary, and 4 years studying at the North American College in Rome.
